<u>9)Co-Opting Councillor</u> – A Notice for people to apply to be a Co-Opted Councillor had been displayed in Notice Boards and on the website. A secret Ballot for Councillors will be held at the March meeting.

<u>10)Planning Application PA18/00110</u> <u>- Cowling</u> – Land at Wainhouse Corner. – To demolish Agricultural Building and construct a 3 bedroom dwelling. Councillors support this application for the following reasons:-

- 1. Policy 1 in favour of the presumption of sustainable development.
- 2. Policy 7 housing in the countryside the proposed dwelling is of a similar size, scale and bulk to the existing building and in addition is of appropriate scale and character to its location. The proposal is using a dis-used building currently in non-residential use and will provide an additional home for a local person currently living with their parents.
- 3. The local services would benefit from an additional dwelling and increase building density to ensure the most efficient use of land referred to under Policy 21.
- <u>11)Broadband</u> Cllr.Osborne reported that there is a problem at the Camelford
  . Exchange and it will now be the end of February before the School Broadband
  can be connected.
- <u>12)Footpaths</u> Mrs Carter reported that a stile at Poulza Post needs replacing and a rail needs repairing. Cllr Chapman will contact Sam Breyley.
- <u>13)Speakers</u> Suggested Speakers for the Parish Meeting was County Cllr. Nicky Chopak, Headmistress Mrs Russell, Mr John Andrews, Coastwatch and Mrs Marion McDonald, Children's Hospice SW.
- <u>14)Safeguarding</u> It was proposed Cllr.Osborne be the Safeguarding Officer for the Council. Proposed Cllr.Chapman Seconded Cllr.Pallett.
- <u>**15)Data** Discuss this at the April meeting and elect a separate Officer</u> for this.
- <u>16)Councillor Matters</u> It was reported that a Security Light at the Big Wave Campers site makes it difficult to turn right at the Junction. Also there were complaints about the Wind Turbine at Beckaveans being very noisy since it was repaired in December. Cllr.Chopak to look into both matters
