- 2) Declaration of Interest/Dispensations Cllr. Osborne declared an interest in Item 9d on the Agenda and left the room at the appropriate time.
- 3) Minutes The minutes of the previous meeting were read and signed.
- <u>4) Balance at Bank</u> The balance at the Bank was reported as £14,123.29 in the Current A/C and £8,376.12 in the Primrose A/C.
- <u>5) Electoral Review of Cornwall</u> The Boundary Commission is embarking on a short period of consultation on the future number of Councillors for Cornwall Council to take effect in the elections in 2021. They are proposing to reduce the number of Councillors to 87. Clerk to reply saying Jacobstow Councillors feel the number should not be reduced but kept as it is now.
