- <u>1.</u> <u>Attendance</u> Cllr. Charmaine Smith chaired the May meeting with Cllrs. I Franklyn, R Reason, D Adey and P Chapman and two members of the public attending. Apologies received from Cllrs. Norman Osborne, Ray Fox and County Cllr. Nicky Chopak.
- <u>2.</u> <u>AGM</u> As this was the Annual General Meeting it began with the election of Officers.
- <u>3.</u> <u>Chairman</u> Re-Election of Cllr Norman Osborne, Proposed Cllr. C Smith Seconded Cllr.D Adey. Unanimously agreed.
- <u>4.</u> <u>Vice-Chairperson</u> Re-Election of Cllr.C Smith as Vice-Chairperson. Proposed Cllr.D Adey Seconded Cllr.I Franklyn. Unanimously agreed.
- <u>5.</u> <u>Responsible Financial Officer</u> Re-Election of Mrs D Turner. Proposed Cllr. P Chapman Seconded R Reason. Unanimously agreed.
- 6. Declaration of Interest/Dispensation. No declarations.
- **<u>7.</u>** <u>*Minutes –*</u> The minutes of the previous meeting were read and signed as correct.
- <u>8.</u> <u>Community Benefit Fund</u> Councillors Approved the Policy and Claim Form to be sent to persons wishing to claim a grant.
- <u>9.</u> <u>Annual Audit</u> The Audit form Statement of Accounts Section 2 was completed by the Responsible Financial Officer and signed. The meeting approved the Accounts and these were signed by the Vice-Chairperson. Section 1 Annual Governance Statement was completed on behalf of the Councillors and signed by the Vice-Chairperson and the Clerk.
